Looking after the reserve

PLEASE OBSERVE THESE COMMON SENSE RULES TO ENABLE THE RESERVE TO BE MAINTAINED
IN A PEACEFUL, SAFE, AND ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY MANNER.



Camping

- Normal road rules apply and are enforceable on ALL roads and tracks on this reserve.
- You **must** register in and pay the prescribed fee **before** setting up your campsite.
- All tents and caravans may only be set up within the designated camping areas (please refer to map). All campsites are unpowered.
- Please park your vehicle as close as possible to your tent and do not block access for other campers
- When setting up your tent please do not engage in any earthworks such as digging trenches around your site, or cutting steps in the embankments etc.
- Please do not operate generators between the hours of 10.00pm. and 8.00am. Noise levels should be kept to a minimum during this time.
- **GARBAGE**. Please take your garbage home with you. Free Garbage Bags are available from the Kiosk



Fires

- Chainsaws are not permitted on this Reserve
- Fires may only be lit in the constructed fireplaces that have been provided. It is illegal to light fires outside constructed fireplaces.
- Visitors may not construct fireplaces.
- In busy times please share fireplaces and taps with other campers.
- Due to rapid soil erosion caused by removing timber from slopes, firewood may not be collected within the valley.
- *During total firebans the use of gas cooking equipment is permitted under certain conditions. Please consult with the caves officers for correct procedures.*



General Rules

- It is illegal to enter any cave without the permission of Caves staff . Permits to enter Caves may be obtained from the office.
- For your own safety keep to the walking tracks.
- Do not Climb any rockface, outcrop, or slope.
- Prevent damage to the public facilities by properly supervising your children.
- Place all rubbish in the bins provided or better still, take it home with you to recycle.
- To protect wildlife, **pets are not allowed on the reserve.**
- Firearms, or other weapons are not permitted.
- Drive slowly and carefully in the reserve - Watch for children.
- Fishing Licences are required for any fishing activities in Grove Greek
- Fossicking is permitted in an area which is specially set-aside. Please check with Caves Staff.
- Please remember that all visitors have the right to peaceful relaxation.
- **CYCLISTS (Including children)** must wear a helmet when riding cycles on this reserve

Failure to comply with any of these regulations may lead to either removal from the Caves reserve or prosecution.



Emergencies

In the event of an emergency after working hours - a member of staff can be contacted by phoning the number shown on the kiosk door. The public phone is outside the visitor centre.
